Background and Objectives

The ACR established the Senior and/or Retired Section of Membership (SRS) in 2015. The mission was determined as, "The mission of the Senior and/or Retired section is to enhance the experience of senior (over 65 and/or retired) members in the ACR by promoting fellowship and interaction amongst the members; communicating opportunities for continued professional involvement including mentorship, career transition and leadership training with other groups in the ACR; enhancing retirement opportunities such as service, financial planning, and recreation; and encouraging members to be ambassadors of the ACR to fellow physicians, health care organizations, and patients."


A feedback survey was sent to 3,000 ACR members aged 60 and over to better understand the needs and desires of its constituent group as we refine the program moving forward.







3. How long have you been semi-retired?

4. About how many hours do you work in a typical week?




5. Which of the following includes your age?



6. About how many hours do you work in a typical week?






8. How long have you been fully retired?




9. Which of the following includes your age?


10. How long have you been semi-retired?



11. About how many hours do you work in a typical week?



12. Which of the following includes your age?













17. Which of the following do you think the SRS should definitely offer to provide value to its members? Please select all that apply













19. How important is it that the SRS have a governance structure to assure succession planning?


There were three main categories that participants wanted to see:

 - Transition to retirement




22. What functions or activities do you think a group such as the SRS should provide to be of value to you in the future? Please select all that apply


23. Below are several functions and activities. Please indicate how much you think the Senior and Retired Section (SRS) should be involved with each.




24. In what state or U.S. territory do you currently reside? (top 12)
